# Michah (Micah) 7:18-19 .וְתַשִּׁלִידְ בִּמִצְלוֹת יָם כָּל-חַטּאתָם.

V'tashlich bim-tzu-lot yam kol cha-to-tam.

"Who is a God like you, pardoning the sin and overlooking the crimes of the remnant of his heritage? He does not retain his anger forever, because he delights in grace. He will again have compassion on us, he will subdue our iniquities. You will throw all their sins into the depths of the sea."

#### Tehillim (Psalms) 103:10-13

"He has not treated us as our sins deserve or paid us back for our offenses, because his mercy toward those who fear him is as far above earth as heaven. He has removed our sins from us as far as the east is from the west. Just as a father has compassion on his children, *ADONAI* has compassion on those who fear him."

#### Eichah (Lamentations) 5:21

"ADONAI, turn us back to you; and we will come back; renew our days, as they were in the past..."

### Messianic Jews (Hebrews) 10:17-18

" ... 'And their sins and their wickednesses I will remember no more.' Now where there is forgiveness for these, an offering for sins is no longer needed."

#### Acts 3:19-20

"Therefore, repent and turn to God, so that your sins may be erased; so that times of refreshing may come from the Lord's presence; and he may send the Messiah appointed in advance for you, that is, Yeshua."

#### 1 Yochanan (1 John) 1:7b-9

"...the blood of his Son Yeshua purifies us from all sin. If we claim not to have sin, we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we acknowledge our sins, then, since He is trustworthy and just, He will forgive them and purify us from all wrongdoing."

#### 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

"Now, brothers, we want you to know the truth about those who have died; otherwise, you might become sad the way other people do who have nothing to hope for. For since we believe that Yeshua died and rose again, we also believe that in the same way God, through Yeshua, will take with Him those who have died. When we say this, we base it on the Lord's own word: we who remain alive when the Lord comes will certainly not take precedence over those who have died. For the Lord himself will come down from heaven with a rousing cry, with a call from one of the ruling angels, and with God's *shofar*; those who died united with the Messiah will be the first to rise; then we who are left still alive will be caught up with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air; and thus we will always be with the Lord. So encourage each other with these words."
